
The AfDB in brief



- Created on 4 August 1963 in Khartoum, Sudan
- Member institutions:
 - The African Development Bank (ADB)
 - The African Development Fund (ADF)
 - The Nigeria Trust Fund (NTF)
- Shareholders
 - 54 African or regional member countries (RMCs)
 - 26 non-African or non-regional member countries (NRMCs)
- Mission: promoting investment of public and private capital in projects and programs designed to reduce poverty and improve living conditions in Africa.
- Sector Approvals, 2012
 - Infrastructure: UA 1.76 billion (48.9 % of total loans and grants)
 - o Social: UA 525.3 million (14.6 %)
 - Multisector: UA 505.4 million (14.0 %)
 - o Finance: UA 402.8 million (11.2 %)
 - Agriculture and Rural Development: UA 308.1 million (8.6 %)
 - Industry, Mining and Quarrying: UA 97.7 million (2.7 %)
- Of which: Loans for UA 2.98 billion (55 operations) and Grants for UA 623 million (80 operations)







Yearly Average Contracts




 Contracts signed for projects financed by the Bank from 2009 to 2013 in Borrowing Countries




Top 10 Borrowing Countries in 2013
