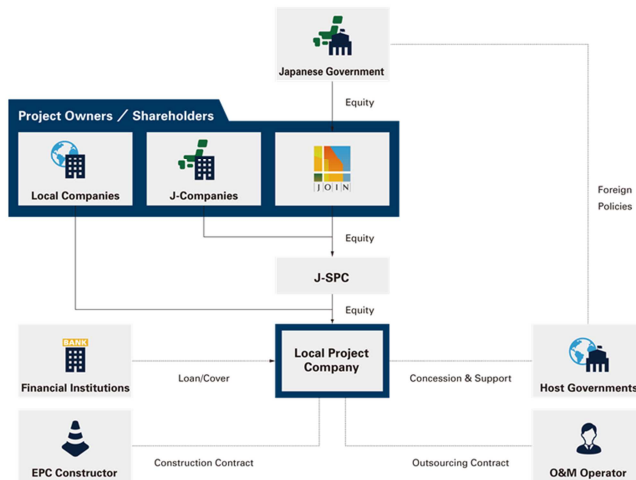
Providing Services
